

Football and English Camp in partnership with Ipswich Town Football Club





Our Football camp is perfect for students who want to improve their football skills whilst developing their English alongside other students with a shared passion for the beautiful game. This camp is best suited to those with prior football experience.

ITFC (Ipswich Town Football Club) football coaches are licensed and qualified for junior football training and the sessions are designed to develop players based on their age and ability.

This 2-week camp will consist of 1-2 football training sessions per day (except excursion days) delivered in English. Students can then choose to support their English learning through structured EFL lessons or multiactivity sessions.

Course Includes

Training sessions can take place on both indoor and outdoor pitches where coaches take time to improve technical ability, enhance individual skills and practice team building as well. Our aim throughout the course is that everyone is supported according to his or her individual criteria and abilities.

A special highlight of this course is that players will go on a stadium tour during one of their excursions. All players will get to visit a Premeir League stadium during their London excursion. Students will also be awarded with a certificate at the end of the 2-weeks.

The course will also include the chance to play against a local team in a friendly match, where students can test their new skills and experience playing against international players.

Equipment Required

Players will need to bring enough football training clothing with them to wear throughout the camp, including trainers for indoor training and synthetic pitches and football boots for grass pitches. Shin pads are required for matches.



Intensive English Course

The Intensive English Camp is an ESL camp with a concentrated and comprehensive approach to the teaching of English. This camp offers students 18 hours of English teaching every week in small groups of a maximum of 3 students. The student lets us know in advance of travelling to the UK which topics they would like to focus on and our experienced teachers create bespoke lesson plans to suit each student's particular requests. This camp is particularly suitable for students revising for a specific exam as our teachers can tailor the lessons to suit the demands of their exam board.



Advantages of small group teaching include:

Flexibility

Teachers can easily adapt classes by allocating more or less time to topics to meet the needs of the individual students. Due to the small class sizes, the teacher becomes more familiar with the students and can tailor their lessons to suit the individual student's method of learning.

Inspiring confidence

Many children are too shy to participate in large class discussions as they do not have enough self-belief in their ability to speak in the target language in front of such a large group. The small group teaching creates a more informal atmosphere in which students feel more comfortable and are encouraged to communicate in English.



Better feedback

In a small group, feedback can move beyond marked work and an A* – F grade. Due to the relaxed, informal environment, students receive more instant oral feedback in class which leads to more overall feedback per student in comparison to the larger classes. In general, small group teaching allows more direct communication between the teacher and student.

Building team working skills

Due to its nature, small group teaching encourages teamwork skills as students are often given small problems or tasks to complete together as a group of 3. In this way, the small group teaching supports both academic and social development.

This course is perfect for students who would like to have a heightened focus on their language acquisition during their trip to the UK. It provides them with a challenging and yet supportive environment to focus on learning English whilst giving them the opportunity to participate in fun activities and go on excursions.


This 2-week rugby camp consists of 30 hours of training sessions delivered in English supported by 30 hours of English language lessons and two cultural excursions. The sessions will be broken up focusing on different areas of athletic development, training and assessment such as game management and core skills.

Delivering the course will be elite-level coaches from PSA Academies who have a wealth of experience from all areas of the game both domestically and internationally.

Horse Riding is both a sport and a pastime enjoyed worldwide – our course focuses on the sporting elements of show jumping and dressage as well as covering the basics of grooming and stable management.

Our Horse Riding Camp is perfect for students who have a love of horses and would like to improve their stable management and riding ability alongside developing their English language skills with other keen riders.

This 2-week course is suitable for both beginner and more advanced riders, however we would recommend students to have some experience of being around horses.

When our Horse Riding students are not at the stables, they will be on-campus taking part in either fun and interactive EFL lessons, or a programme of adventure activities in addition to enjoying excursions to local towns, cities or attractions.

Course Includes

This 2-week long course includes 15 hours at the stables; there will be 5 sessions over 2 weeks in either the morning or afternoon (Wednesdays will be reserved for an excursion). The students will have half a session of riding and half a session of stable management.

Our riding instructors are Pony Club qualified and will begin by assessing all students, including basic riding positions in walk, trot and canter.

During the course, students will also learn stable management and how to safely handle the horse, including securely tying up, leading, grooming, tacking up and feeding.

At the end of the 2-weeks, our riders will have the opportunity to show off new skills with a 'Dressage and Show Jumping competition' where rosettes will be awarded. Students should have a much better understanding of equestrian care and stable management and will have improved their riding ability.

Equipment Required

Students should not bring riding helmets, all helmets and equipment will be provided due to British standards. Riders are welcome to bring their own specific riding clothing such as jodhpurs and boots.

The aim of this 2-week STEM challenge is to design, analyse, make, test, modify and then race a model F1 car.

Seems straightforward? This course is so much more, in addition to applying science, students will also need to apply real life skills such as project management, teamwork skills, following instructions, speaking and listening skills in English as well as recognising their own and others personal strengths.

Each course will cater for a maximum of 18 participants, allowing for 3 teams of 6 students. Each team will consist of a Team Project Manager, Manufacturing Engineer, Design Engineer, Graphic Designer and Resource Manager.

Highlights

Not interested in Motor Racing or STEM? This camp is still for you! It offers a fantastic opportunity for young adults to explore lots of valuable real-life transferrable skills in a fun, interactive summer camp environment.

Course Includes

The camp will be delivered in 3-hour sessions on 8 mornings or afternoons over the 2-weeks, totalling 24 hours for the course.

During the sessions, the following topics will be covered:

- Research, design and make a model Formula 1 car
- Analysis of what will impact the car's performance, such as air resistance, gravity and air pressure
- How to develop ideas through sketching, including:
- Design features that will help the car go faster
- Identifying causes that would slow the car
- Styling the car
- Testing the car's performance and aerodynamic performance

Equipment Required

No equipment needed, this course is fully resourced.



An overview of our Language Provision

Our Approach



Why use a blended approach?


A blended approach to English language learning is a method of delivery that combines live, teacher-led lessons (either in a conventional or in a virtual classroom) with digital learning.


A blended approach offers:


What's available
